Re: Funding request for bussing for November 11, 2018

The Venice Middle Young Marines and the Venice Middle School Band are requesting funding for transportation to participate in the City of Sarasota Veterans Day Parade on Sunday, November 11, 2018. VMS has participated in the parade honoring our veterans for the last 6 years.

There will be 130 VMYM and 60 VMS Band members participating. VMYM Staff, Ian Ackroyd, and approved chaperones will supervise the students on the bus and throughout the parade. We need bus seating for 210 people and space for the band instruments.

We are requesting funding in the amount of \$2000.

We obtained pricing quotes from several area charter bus companies and the Sarasota County School Board Transportation department.

Sarasota County School Board buses: we would need 5 - 55 passenger buses to accommodate the students, chaperones, and band instruments (instruments on seats.) Each bus is estimated to cost \$409.19 for a total of \$2045.95.

All Around Charter buses: we would need 4 buses to accommodate the students, chaperones, and instruments (storage available under the bus.) Each bus is estimated to cost \$500 for a total of \$2000.

Using the charter buses would be much more efficient for storing the band instruments.
