

## CHAPTER 4.00 - CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

### STUDENT PUBLICATIONS

4.51

School principals are responsible for ensuring the appropriateness of printed and other materials produced by the school for distribution to students, parents, as defined by Florida Statutes, and the local school community.

- I. The principal shall be responsible for supervising the publication of newspapers, magazines, yearbooks, non-print mediums, and programs and for ensuring these forms of communication do not impede or otherwise interfere with the educational purpose of the school. Publications shall conform with related policy.
- II. The principal shall not allow advertisements of intoxicants, tobacco products or sexually explicit material.
