Teachers (includes counselors, media specialists, etc.):

The Ashton SAC Organizational Plan allows for one teacher representative from each grade level/team. The representative is elected by the team members. If a vacancy is created, grade level members elect a new representative to serve out the term.

Classified:

One SAC member represents all of the classified personnel on Ashton's staff. This member is elected by vote of the classified staff. If a vacancy is created, classified personnel elect a new representative to serve out the term.

Parents:

Parents are encouraged to volunteer to serve as SAC members. Parents who are interested are then voted on and approved by the SAC.

Other Citizen:


Volunteers are solicited from business partners. The principal makes the final decision on individual(s) who will serve on SAC in the capacity of community/business representative.

Students:

Two representatives from every fifth grade class make up the Ashton Ambassadors. From this group of Ambassadors, two students are elected to serve on the SAC representing the students of Ashton Elementary.

Chairperson:

The chairperson is elected by consensus of all SAC members at the first SAC meeting of the year.
