



School Health Requirements

For Attendance 2021-2022



The school year begins August 10, 2021. Prepare now!

Take your children for an annual physical exam and get them any needed immunizations.

A physical exam, signed and stamped by a licensed provider and dated within one year prior to registration, is required for each student initially entering a Florida school. This is proof that body systems (heart, skin, lungs) were examined.

Up-to-date immunizations are required - see table at left.

- ✓ DOH-Sarasota provides free childhood immunizations.
- ✓ Appointments are required.

Form DH680 is required for school entry.

All immunization dates must be on a Florida Certificate of Immunization (DH680). Contact your physician or DOH-Sarasota for the form. If your child is new to Florida schools, send their existing immunization records to DOH-Sarasota via:

You will be notified if your child is missing any immunizations and should then call for an immunization appointment.

Florida School Immunization Requirements (2021-2022)

Pre-Kindergarten

- 4 DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis)
- 3 Polio
- 4 Hib (Haemophilus Influenzae Type B)
- 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 1 Varicella (Chicken pox)
- At least 1 PCV 13 (Pneumococcal Conjugate)

Kindergarten, Grades 1 - 6

- 5 DTaP (for K, last dose on/after 4th birthday)
- 4 Polio (last dose on/after 4th birthday)
- 2 MMR
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 2 Varicella (for K and grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6)

Grades 7 - 12

- 5 DTaP
- 4 Polio (last dose on/after 4th birthday)
- 2 MMR
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 1 TDaP
- 2 Varicella (chicken pox) for grades 7 - 12
