Rule 6A-1.094123, F.A.C. is to establish procedures for school districts to plan and document delivery of required instruction related to Internet safety and injury prevention/safety concepts to specifically address child trafficking prevention for grades K-12 students. School districts must annually provide instruction to students in grades K-12 related to child trafficking prevention and awareness.

What does the P.A.U.S.E acronym stand for?

PAUSE is a set of strategies that can help us stay safe and can guide us through uncomfortable situations.

- P**owering in learning
- A**ll secrets can be told
- U** are the boss of your own body
- S**afe adults are there to help
- E**veryone can find their voice.

What is the difference between a surprise and an unsafe secret?

Surprises make you feel happy and excited to tell your friends. Unsafe secrets make you feel yucky, confused, or scared. No one should ask you to keep a secret that makes you feel sad or scared inside.

What is the 'Bathing Suit Zone?'

The part of your body covered by your bathing suit is your bathing suit zone.

What are the Body Safety Rules?

- No one should touch or ask to see your bathing suit zone.
- You should not be touching anyone else's bathing suit zone.
- No one should take pictures of your bathing suit zone.
- No one should show you pictures of another person's bathing suit zone.

What is a Trust Triangle?

Your Trust Triangle is made up of 3 safe adults who are trusting, loving, and protect you. Your Trust Triangle can include safe adults at home or school.
