Rule 6A-1.094123, F.A.C. is to establish procedures for school districts to plan and document delivery of required instruction related to Internet safety and injury prevention/safety concepts to specifically address child trafficking prevention for grades K-12 students. School districts must annually provide instruction to students in grades K-12 related to child trafficking prevention and awareness.

Key Points and Additional Information

The Safety Rules are strategies designed to help students identify and respond to abuse and other types of victimization. Students are introduced to the 5 Safety Rules and how they can be used to keep themselves safe.



What is the difference between a surprise and an unsafe secret?

Surprises make you feel happy and excited to tell your friends. Unsafe secrets make you feel yucky, confused, or scared. No one should ask you to keep a secret that makes you feel sad or scared inside.

What are the Body Safety Rules?

- No one should touch or ask to see your private body parts.
- You should not be touching anyone else's private body parts.
- No one should take pictures of your private body parts.
