- » **Step 1 //** In order to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) online you will need the previous year's tax returns for yourself and/or your parent(s)/guardian(s).
- » **Step 2 //** Go to <https://www.fafsa.ed.gov>. Create an FAFSA Username and Password. You will need this in order to sign your application electronically.
- » **Step 3 //** Follow the directions for filling out your FAFSA.
- » **Step 4 //** When asked what schools you want to receive your application, enter Suncoast Technical College's school code (**013689**). Be sure to save and submit your application.
- » **Step 5 //** One week after submitting your FAFSA, **you must contact Suncoast Technical College to verify your application has been received.** At this time, further information will be provided as to the next steps in completing your financial aid file.
- » **Step 6 //** It is a possibility that you may be selected for document verification. This means, that tax returns and other documents will need to be submitted to our financial aid office. Please understand that Suncoast Technical College has no control over verification selections.

NOTE: In order to be considered eligible for financial aid, applicants must have either a standard high school diploma or a GED.

NOTE: Submission of financial aid request does not guarantee an applicant will receive financial assistance. If aid is granted, student must understand that the initial disbursement may not be sufficient to cover all fees due at the time of registration. All students must be prepared to make payment of applicable fees at time of registration.
