

Time is running out...don't let your flexible spending account (FSA) vanish!

If you have a Flexible Spending Account (FSA) for the current calendar year (2023), all expenses must be incurred by December 31, 2023.

Based on IRS rules, the plan requires you to use all of the money in your account(s) by the end of the plan year on December 31, 2023, and submit claims for reimbursement by March 31, 2024, or you will lose the remaining balance.

Certification Updates

ADDITIONAL PATHWAYS TO THE PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

 General Knowledge Exam Waiver waives passage of the general knowledge (GK) test for an educator who has been provided three years of supports and instruction after failing the GK test and who has been rated effective or highly effective for each of the last three years.



- Professional Education Test Waiver eliminates passage of the
 professional education test for an educator who has successfully completed a professional
 education competency (PEC) program, completed the professional preparation courses, and
 who has been rated effective or highly effective for three years.
- Subject Area Mastery Waiver for Subject Area Exam will allow educators to demonstrate subject area mastery if they have a master's or higher degree in a bachelor level subject area for which a Florida subject area examination exists.

DOE UPDATES

- Temporary Certificates are valid for five years (excluding SLP and Athletic Coaching certificates).
- The Reading K-12 subject area exam can no longer be used to add the Reading Endorsement after July 1, 2024.
- Educators with the ESE K-12 coverage must complete 40 Reading Renewal credits to renew beginning August 30, 2030.
- Educators with the Educational Leadership coverage must earn a minimum of 20 in-service credits in Florida's Educational Leadership Standards to renew beginning August 30, 2030.
