PATHWAYS TO HEALTH

Important Medical Plan Information

Important information! The June 30, 2023 deadline is fast approaching for the Pathways to Health, a new voluntary program that applies to employees on the district's medical plan.

This voluntary program requires employees who would like to continue the option of electing any of the 4 medical plans at \$0 cost for the Employee Only tier coverage to obtain a preventative wellness exam once every 24 months. Those who do not obtain their preventative wellness exam will only have the Low PPO at \$0 cost for Employee Only tier.

DELTA DENTAL

Dental Plan Highlights:

- Dental plan covers two exams/cleanings per 12 month period at \$0 cost with an in-network provider
- \$50 deductible per person/\$150 family
- \$1,500 maximum reimbursement per each covered member per calendar year
- \$1,500 lifetime maximum for Orthodontics

Difference between PPO/Premier vs. Out-of-Network:

- PPO (Preferred Provider Organization) will maximize your savings and lower out of pocket costs
- Premier Plan managed fees for service, and is not contractually obligated to charge allowed fees
- PPO and Premier plans will file claims on your behalf
- Out of Network dentists you may be responsible for paying the dentist the full amount for the services and submitting the claim to Delta Dental after your visit

CERTIFICATION CORNER

Instructional Contract renewal is contingent upon meeting all certification requirements listed below by June 30:

- Professional certificates that expire 06/30/2023: Submit Renewal application on the DOE website and return \$75 application fee to Heather Walsh in HR by 06/30/2023.
- Temporary certificates that expire 06/30/2023: Complete Professional certificate requirements and apply to upgrade on the DOE website as soon as possible.
- Endorsement out-of-field requirements: All 2022-2023 school year out-of-field requirements must be completed by 06/30/2023.
 - ESOL endorsement must complete one course
 - Gifted/ASD endorsement must complete two courses

Once all courses/requirements are completed, apply to add the endorsement to your certificate.

Subject area out-of-field requirements

 Pass the subject area exam and apply to add to certificate by 06/30/2023. (Allow 4 to 6 weeks processing time).
