FINANCIAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING SUMMARY MINUTES 5/3/2023

Bonnie Penner presented the proposed policy which would formally establish the FAC. There was discussion among members present regarding the future number of members and appointment process. It was suggested that the committee size be reduced to 7, with each Board Member appointing one member and the Committee appointing two at-large members. There was also discussion on the proposed terms.

Chair Truitt Indicated yes and a term that coincides with the 2024 school board election. Members Collins and Ippilito indicated they would serve as the at-large members with terms tied to the 2026 school board elections.

### IV. Legislative Update

Bonnie talked about the Legislative update on the House Bill I-Scholarships that would be paid for through the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP). There was discussion about the per student awards that is based on the number of students at Sarasota County Schools that is reported. There was also discussion on the Charter Schools FTE funds where Sarasota County Schools would keep a portion of the funding for the Charter schools but as for the private schools the funding goes straight to the private schools. There was also some discussion regarding the universal scholarships likely having a minimal impact on our district because we are an "A" district with a full compliment of charter and private educational offerings.

# V. Local Budget Process Update

Bonnie talked about the local budget process update. She also talked about the 45-day intervention regarding behavioral issues. There was also discussion on an additional need for guidance counselors.
