

CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

DISRUPTIONS AT SCHOOL BOARD FUNCTIONS

3.41

No person shall knowingly disrupt or interfere with a School Board function. This includes persons who knowingly advise, counsel, or instruct any person to disrupt any function or activity. The School Board Chairperson may order the removal from a public meeting held by the School Board of any person interfering with the expeditious or orderly process of the meeting if the Chairperson has first issued a warning that continued interference with the orderly processes of the meeting will result in removal. Any person causing a disruption to any other school function shall be advised to immediately leave the school premises or facility where the function is being conducted.

- I. Any person who purchased an admission ticket to a school event shall forfeit his/her rights under this rule by having disrupted or interfered with the event.
- II. Any person who has been given notice by a school official and either fails to leave the premises or leaves the premises and subsequently returns to the premises shall be deemed a trespasser.
