

CHAPTER 5.00 – STUDENTS

GRANTING PERMISSION FOR STUDENTS TO LEAVE THE SCHOOL CAMPUS

5.35

- I. No student shall be permitted to leave the school grounds during the school day for school business/activities without the principal or designee's prior approval or written consent from the student's parent(s), as defined by Florida Statutes, provided an acceptable reason is established.
- II. The principal or designee shall definitely establish the identity and authority of any person who requests the release of a student from school. If the person requesting the release of the student is a person other than the parent/guardian with whom the child resides or is not listed by the parent/guardian on the pick-up list, the principal or designee shall not release the child without the verified authorization of the parent/guardian with whom the child resides.
- III. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to a law enforcement officer, court official, Children and Family Services, or proper school employee; provided, that the person's identity and authority are clearly established.
