

**CHAPTER 9.00 - SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS AND
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS**

VISITORS

9.60

The board encourages parents, as defined by Florida Statutes, and other interested citizens to visit the schools. The principal will regulate visits both within the school and on the campus for purposes of security and to ensure that visitors do not interrupt the instructional program.

- I. Any person entering the premises of a school shall report to the reception desk and make known the purpose of the visit. All visitors shall sign in at the reception desk and comply with all visitor management requirements throughout the duration of their visit and follow the procedures described in Policy 3.40.
- II. A student not enrolled in the school or a student not accompanied by a parent is prohibited from visiting a school unless otherwise approved by the principal.
- III. Parents are invited to visit the schools that their student(s) attends. To avoid interrupting the daily program, the parent should request a conference for after school hours or during a teacher's conference period.
- IV. Any person who enters or remains upon district property without administrative approval may be found to be trespassing and, therefore, in violation of Florida Statutes and subject to arrest and penalties as defined by statutes.
