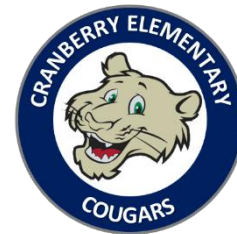


Cranberry Elementary

2018-2019 School Improvement Plan Highlights



School Mission Statement:

Cranberry Elementary School will establish a climate of community and cooperation among all students, parents, teachers, and staff so that all students can reach their fullest potential.

School Vision Statement:

Cranberry Elementary School students will "make tracks towards excellence" in a safe, caring, and respectful environment which promotes life-long learning and socially responsible citizens.

Goal 1:

By the end of the 2019 school year, 73% of our students will score proficient, 60% of all students will demonstrate an annual learning gain, and 54% of students in the lowest 25% will demonstrate an annual learning gain on the FSA ELA Test.

Goal 2:

By the end of the 2019 school year, 75% of our students will score proficient, 67% of all students will demonstrate an annual learning gain, and 51% of students in the lowest 25% will demonstrate an annual learning gain on the FSA Math Test.

Goal 3:

By the end of the 2019 school year, we will maintain 77% of our fifth grade students scoring proficient on the SSA Test.

Goal 4:

By the end of the 2019 school year, the number of students who have less than 90% attendance rate will decrease by ten percent.

Goal 5:

By the end of the 2019 school year, the number of students receiving Office Discipline Referrals will decrease by 5%.
