#### English/Language Arts (ELA)

Reading Wonders, Classroom Texts and iReady LAFS are used for core instruction across ELA. Classroom teachers remediate, enrich and enhance the curriculum with supplemental quality fiction and non-fiction texts and research-based intervention materials. The leveled bookroom has been enhanced to assist teachers with materials for differentiation.

#### Mathematics

Maximizing Math Mentality District program serves as a guide for mathematics instruction with support from iReady MAFS. Students are given the opportunity to solve problems, engage, explore, explain, elaborate and evaluate mathematics skills and concepts. Math journaling gives students the opportunity to talk, think and write about math.

#### Science

Pearson Elevate Science is utilized to explore the world of science with students. All students participate in the Science special to further extend and enrich their understanding. Students in grades K– 5 have an additional STEAM focused special in the school’s Makerspace where students have opportunities to explore the engineering/design process.

Areas of Focus:

- ⇒ Wilkinson Elementary's focus is to **understand standards and ensure that lesson planning and instructional delivery are aligned in all content areas** (ELA, Math and Science) to demonstrate academic gains across the grade levels.
- ⇒ **Social Emotional learning is a focus area for all students.** Ensuring that students are able to manage the domains of SEL such as: cognitive regulation, emotional processes, and social interpersonal skills will result in a more productive academic environment/student growth in the content areas.
- ⇒ **Parent Teacher conferences** will focus on the bridge between home and school.
- ⇒ **Teachers will provide families with a Home School Compact** as well as resources and materials to support learning at home.
- ⇒ **Attendance will continue to be monitored and analyzed.** Students will be recognized monthly and rewarded. Any student with significant attendance issues will meet with the Home School Liaison or School Social Worker to problem-solve an attendance improvement plan.
- ⇒ **ESOL families will be invited to attend quarterly Parent Cafe meetings.** Parents will be informed about academic expectations and given tools and resources to support learning at home.
- ⇒ **Positive Behavior Support** includes individual brag tags earned by students in all aspects of education (academics, behavior and achievement) as well as school-wide challenges and recognitions.
