

Toledo Blade Elementary Student Uniform Policy Mandatory for ALL Students PreK-Grade 5



Tops: Collared Polos, Dresses, Sweaters, Jackets

Top Colors: Gold, White, and Black

- Short or long-sleeved collared polo shirts
- Solid uniform color, with or without logo
- No button up shirts authorized
- Sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets & layered items must be in solid uniform color

Optional:

Logo uniform polo shirts can be ordered online or at Toledo Blade Elementary.
The cost is \$15.00 each. Logo sweatshirts & jackets are also available for order at various times during the year.

Bottoms: Shorts, Pants, Capris, Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers

Bottom Colors: Khaki and Black

- Bottoms must be to mid-thigh with an inseam of 6 inches or more
- Shorts are expected to be worn under skirts
- Leggings (khaki or black only) can be worn <u>under bottoms</u>
- Leggings/jeggings/excessively tight bottoms may not be worn alone
- Athletic/workout shorts and sweatpants are not allowed (Solid blue jeans allowed ONLY on school SPIRIT Days)

Shoes

- Closed toed/Fully enclosed shoes with a sole required.
- Must be tied or closed with Velcro straps
- Sneakers required on PE day(s) and for recess participation

Socks

• Required - Solid uniform colors "preferred"

School Spirit Days

"Last School Day of the Week"

Solid blue jeans/denim and any TBES polo/spirit t-shirts are optional

Free Days

To be announced by administration

Picture Days

For Class Picture Days: Full uniform required

Individual Picture Days: Students may dress out of uniform, but in full compliance with dress code expectations

Field Trips

Full uniform required on all field trips unless approved by administration

Enforcement

- 1st Offense: Call, note home & change into uniform attire
- 2nd Offense: Call, note home & change into uniform attire
- After 5 days of non-compliance: Letter mailed to the home and administrative team intervention

Applications for assistance are available from the Guidance Department and are subject to approval (verification of eligibility required)

Toledo Blade Traffic Plan For Arrival & Dismissal

Please adhere to the prescribed traffic pattern and procedures to safely accommodate the volume of car riders, bike riders, and walkers at Toledo Blade.

The traffic pattern allows for two car arrival/dismissal locations that are designated by grade level. The facility design and procedures have been established in our continued efforts to make the Toledo Blade campus a safe and secure environment for our families.

Some helpful reminders to help keep our campus safe & orderly during arrival and dismissal:

Arrival

- Students arriving before **8:00am** should report directly to the main office. If the student is registered for the Before School Care Program, he/ she will be sent to the appropriate location. If he/she is not registered, parents will be notified and fees will be applied. **Children should not be left unattended on campus prior to 8:00am**
- Bike riders/walkers should **only** enter campus at the supervised crosswalk
- Bike riders must have a "Bike Rider" authorization form on file in the office
- Classroom doors open at 8:15am; Students arriving between 8-8:15am will be directed to the cafeteria for quiet reading time and/or breakfast service
- Parents may park in designated parking spaces and check in the front office <u>if</u> arriving for school business (ex. Scheduled meetings, clinic, volunteering, etc.)
- Parents wishing to walk students to the classroom may do so between 8:15-8:30am following the detailed procedures outlined in the family handbook located on our website

Dismissal

- All dismissal changes must be submitted in writing to the office before 2:00pm
- Early release after <u>2:45pm</u> is not permitted unless prior arrangements have been approved

Car Rider

Utilize the grade level assigned location for arrival & dismissal

Loop(s)

- ⇒ Families with students in multiple grade levels will use the location assigned to the youngest sibling
- Travel at posted speeds and adhere to traffic flow patterns
- Remain in the vehicle at all times with a <u>hang tag clearly displayed</u> and <u>photo ID</u> available
- You will be asked to visit the front office if the hang tag is not displayed or staff request verification of ID





- Pull to the farthest open designated gate to load along the curbside
- Children will be dismissed from a "dismissal classroom" and directed to the assigned dismissal location/gate

Schools qualify for Title 1 support based on the percentage of students/families who qualify for the free/reduced lunch program.


Children are not required to eat school lunch if they qualify for the F/R program. Families can choose to pack lunches or utilize the breakfast and lunch service as they like.













