<p>Bus riders will arrive on campus each morning between 7:45 a.m-8:00a.m.</p> <p>Students that eat breakfast will be dismissed to the cafeteria upon arrival.</p> <p>Students not needing to eat will be dismissed at 8:00 a.m. to walk to class.</p>	<p>Students wishing to eat breakfast may be dropped off in our car loop starting at 7:45 a.m. each morning. Students not wishing to eat breakfast on campus should arrive at 8:00 a.m. Families should pull forward to the front of the line to keep the line moving.</p> <p>Students should have their personal belongings in hand and be ready to exit the car at the designated area. For safety reasons, students may not be on campus any earlier than 7:45 a.m. Students who are found on campus prior to 7:45 a.m. will be taken to our fee-based before care program. Parents will be responsible for paying any cost associated with the use of this program.</p>	<p>Bike riders and walkers enter campus from Glenallen Blvd. closest to the Narramore Soccer fields (Back of campus). Students that eat breakfast are able to enter the campus at 7:45 a.m. All other bike riders and walkers are able to enter the campus at 8:00 a.m.</p> <p>Bike riders will need to place their bikes in the bike rack near the P.E. area before reporting to the cafeteria or classroom.</p> <p>**This area is unsupervised prior to 7:45 a.m., so please do not have students arrive prior to that time.</p>	<p>The Before Care program is a fee based program that operates on all regular school days. The Before Care program opens at 6:15 a.m. and ends at 7:45 a.m. at which time the students are dismissed to breakfast or their classrooms.</p> <p><u>Please note:</u> The Before Care program requires pre-registration.</p>

Visitors will not be allowed on campus during arrival or dismissal.

Parents should have their car rider tag displayed in the front windshield of the passenger side of their car.
