Media Center Updates


Sarasota County Schools has implemented new Media Center systems to enhance transparency and keep you informed about your student's reading habits.

Automated Book Checkout Notifications: This automatically generates email notifications each time your student checks out a book from the Media Center. It provides you with real-time information about the materials your child is exploring and foster a deeper connection between home and school in support of your child's literacy journey.

How it Works: When your student checks out a book, you will receive an email notification containing details such as the book title, author, and due date. This automated process ensures you stay informed without any additional effort on your part. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the notification emails, feel free to reach out to our **Media Aide, Ms. Rivera**.

Benefits of the New System:

- 1. Transparency: Instantly know which books your child is borrowing from the Media Center.
- 2. Encouragement: Use the information to engage in conversations about the books your child is interested in and support their reading journey.
- 3. Timely Returns: Stay on top of due dates and help your child return books on time to make room for new reading adventures.
