What's Happening around Campus

High School Visits

The counseling teams from Riverview and Sarasota High will be visiting our campus soon to begin the scheduling process for 9th grade. Below are important dates to mark on your calendars. <u>These</u> events are during the school day for students only.

We would like to announce a new program starting at SMS called "Ripples From SMS". The concept was born when in October of 2023, staff member Marjie Smith was awarded the Ripple Effect Teacher Award from the Margery and Charles Barancik Foundation, a recognition that came with a monetary award. Mrs. Barancik was noted as saying, "We can't change the world, but we can change little pieces of it and hope for a ripple effect." Mrs. Smith is one of



those people whose actions have left a ripple of positivity at Sarasota Middle. She has decided to follow Mrs. Barancik's lead and has created "Ripples from SMS."

Every action creates a ripple that affects the larger currents of life. The things we do, the actions we take, the words we say, our attitudes – all create ripples. Our ripples start more ripples – and those ripples continue through our lives and the lives of others - creating a greater influence. This program is designed to help SMS students and staff "give back" to our community – to look at how they can help, where they can help, where they can make a difference and what they can do to better our community.

Each quarter during the school year, SMS students or staff members are eligible to be recognized for their efforts – with a cash award of \$250. It may be given to a single person or a group. Half of the award money will go to the organization/group benefiting from the student's/staff's efforts and half of the award money will go to the recipient – the honoree.

We hope to continue to create *Ripples from SMS* to our Sarasota community. The inaugural quarter for *Ripples from SMS* will finish after Spring Break. Students, staff, and parents are welcome to nominate an "*SMS Ripple Creator*."
