

Parent, Student, and Staff Communications

- 1. We encourage direct communication with teachers.

Email is fastest for teachers to see.

Phone calls – Staff try to respond within 24-48 hours.

TIPS for Middle School Parents

- Continue to monitor your child's agenda daily/weekly.
- Monitor Schoology for teacher announcements and daily/weekly work.
- Continue to monitor the Parent Portal.
- Communicate with your child's teachers and counselor.
- Pay attention to their workspace at home: free of distractions.
- Provide/encourage them to take breaks as needed.
- Monitor your child's social media sites. Discuss with them the importance of thinking before posting.
