Safe and Supported: Meeting the Needs of Transgender Students

Increasingly, transgender and other gender-expansive students are seeking to attend and be seen at school in their authentic gender. In approaching their schools, however, they often encounter hesitation and/or fear. This session focuses on using Gender Support Plans to identify and account for the myriad questions that need to be answered when a transgender student enters school, or transitions while there. The Gender Support Plan has been used by schools throughout the country to help manage an issue that often keeps everyone up late with worry. The workshop will detail the different components and options necessary for developing a successful Gender Support Plan; more importantly, it will examine the many variables that must be considered along the way, and the trade-offs various approaches will bring.
