

# SAT Administration at Pine View School

Saturday, March 13, 2021

Check-In Begins at 7:15 am

Students planning on taking the SAT at Pine View School should plan to arrive on campus no later than 7:30 am for required check-in.

## Required for Entry

- ◆ **A Face Mask:** All students are required to wear a face mask at all times while on campus.
- ◆ **Photo ID:** Required for entry.
- ◆ **College Board Issued SAT Admission Ticket:** Required for entry.

## Parking, Dropping Off, Picking Up

- ◆ Students may park in the main parking lot, or the student parking lot.
- ◆ Parents may use the parent pickup loop or the bus loop for dropping off and picking up.

*\*Per College Board, only test-taking students are permitted to enter campus.*

## Check-In Procedures

- ◆ Health Statement Form: Prior to Registration, students will be asked 5 short health related questions on a short Health Statement Form, which they will sign.
- ◆ Registration Tables: Students should have ID cards and a paper-copy of their College Board issued SAT Admission Ticket, and signed Health Form ready for Check-In.

## Times

- ◆ Arrival: Plan to arrive on campus between 7:15am and 7:30am for check-in.
- ◆ Testing Rooms: Proceed to assigned testing rooms at 7:30am for pre-testing preparations.
- ◆ Start Time: The SAT will begin ***promptly at 8:00am*** in all testing rooms.
- ◆ Test Completion Times:
  - ◇ Standard SAT: 12:15pm to 12:30pm
  - ◇ SAT with Essay: 1:15pm to 1:30pm

## Other Things to Remember

- ◆ Calculator
- ◆ Snack or Drink: These may be consumed ONLY during breaks.
- ◆ Sweater or Jacket
- ◆ ID and Admission Ticket
