# Babcock Preserve Eco Tour & FPL Babcock Ranch Solar Energy Center (*Punta Gorda, FL*)

**Discover the Natural Heart of Florida** – We will begin the day with a tour of the **Crescent B Ranch**, part of the **Babcock Preserve**. The Swamp Buggy tour will include the Telegraph Cypress Swamp. You will see a working cattle ranch and the natural wildlife of the historic Babcock Ranch. The tour travels through part of 14,000 acres of pasture and ecosystems.



We will enjoy lunch at the **Gator Shack Restaurant** on the Babcock Ranch. You will order off the menu.



Following lunch, we will re-board our bus and travel to the Discovery Center at the FPL Babcock Ranch Solar Energy Community. It was the first solar-powered town in America, located in southwest Florida, north of Ft. Myers. The 400+ acre community features single-family homes, condominiums, townhouses, and a few businesses. It is a planned community powered by solar and built to withstand severe weather. There is an 870-acre solar field with 650,000 individual solar panels operated by FPL. It will power up to 50,000 homes, although there are only about 5,000 homes on Babcock Ranch. The excess power goes back on the grid to service surrounding communities. On cloudy days and nights, a natural gas generator fills the gap.

The Community Center doubles as a reinforced storm shelter. The development is thirty miles inland to avoid coastal storm surge. Powerlines are underground. Large retention ponds surround the development to protect homes from flooding. The streets were designed to absorb floodwaters. Babcock Ranch is the brainchild of Syd Kitson, former professional football player in the 1980s with the Green Bay Packers. We will visit the Discovery Center for a presentation about this solar community and tour a couple of models before heading home from a long but interesting and educational day.

Step back in time to the days of the traveling shows across America. The **International Independent Showmen's Museum** is a uniquely different museum of 54,000 square feet, filled with fun and memories. Our guided tour will highlight the history of the American carnivals, circuses, freak shows, girlie shows, and other gems of Americana. There was the world of the midway with games of chance to separate the carny-goers from their money, the Tilt -a-Whirl, corndogs, and more. Today corporations own the shows, not the eccentric carny families of the 1930s and 1940s.

Gibsonton (also called Gibtown) was the winter home for the people who worked and performed in the carnivals, circuses, and midways. The towns around Tampa and Sarasota were dotted with these types of entertainment, and were an influence on American culture. From the small theater troupes and medicine shows to the large circuses, the Showmen's Museum features it all.
