** Dual enrollment allows high school students to take college classes while they are still enrolled in high school. These classes count for both high school and college credit. Dual enrollment courses are real college courses for real college credit. The grades will go on a student's high school and college transcript. Before enrolling, please make sure that you are ready for the demanding work a college class will require. A poor grade in a DE class may negatively impact a student's college acceptance. Many classes require that the student pass the final exam in order to pass the class.*
