



Dual Enrollment Resources for Pine View Students

What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual enrollment allows high school students to take college classes while they are still enrolled in high school. These classes count for both high school and college credit.

Dual enrollment courses are real college courses for real college credit. The grades will go on a student's high school and college transcript. Before enrolling, please make sure that you are ready for the demanding work a college class will require. **A poor grade in a DE class may negatively impact a student's college acceptance.** Many classes require that the student pass the final exam in order to pass the class.

Tuition and books are free.

INITIAL ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for dual enrollment at USF students must meet or exceed the following academic qualifications:

- Minimum 3.5 weighted high school GPA (Homeschooled Students Exempt)
- Minimum scores on one of the following tests:
 - SAT: 560 on Critical Reading / 530 Math
 - ACT: 21 Reading / 21 Mathematics
 - PERT: 123 Math / 106 Reading / 103 Writing
 - CPT (Accuplacer): 245 Reading / 245 Writing / 250 AAF (**Students must Apply and Have a U#**)
- Digital Submission of an "Approval Form" by a school counselor/administrator as ready for success at the college level of instruction.

Students interested in taking a DE class on the Pine View campus through USF must:

1. Indicate an interest by adding a DE class to their 2022-2023 schedule.
2. Submit a completed Dual Enrollment Approval Form to the guidance office before May 1st, 2022 (the form is included in this packet).
3. Complete the USF online application. (This includes the Residency Information and Immunization Forms) Students must also submit a test score to USF. Please refer to the link above.
4. Have a qualifying test score in hand by the application deadline date. Students must complete the USF application before requesting to take the CPT test with USF.

ENC 1101 (Written Communications 1) and ENC 1102 (Written Communications 2)

LIT 2000 (Introduction to Literature) and LIT 2030 (Introduction to Poetry)

MAC 1105 (College Algebra) and MAC 1147 (Precalculus and Trigonometry)

MAC 2313 (Calculus III) and MAP 2302 (Differential Equations)

AST 2002 (Introduction to Astronomy) and AST 2004 (Stellar Astronomy and Cosmology)

Students who will graduate from high school in 2023 and 2024 will have the opportunity to participate in one of two full-time DE programs through SCF:

ADE (Accelerated Dual Enrollment): Students in grade 11 may begin the two-year program. They will continue to be Pine View students but will attend all of their classes at SCF. This program allows students to earn their high school diploma while also earning an AA degree.

EA: (Early Admission): Students in grade 12 may take all of their classes at SCF while maintaining their Pine View status.

Part-time classes: Students meeting certain prerequisites may have the opportunity to take one or two classes per semester.

Students must have a qualifying test score (ACT/SAT/PERT). Students interested in taking the PERT test must first complete SCF's online application. The PERT test must be taken on the SCF campus.

Students in grades 11 and 12 have the opportunity to take one or two classes per semester online through the University of Florida. UF does not offer summer DE classes.

UF Eligibility Requirements:

- Maintain a 3.6 unweighted GPA.

Take one of the three following standardized tests:

- SAT – with a 1100 composite score.
- ACT – with a 22 composite score.
- PSAT – with a 1130 composite score.

Dual Enrollment Testing Requirement

Students interested in taking dual enrollment classes will need to **complete an application with the college** (SCF, UF, or USF) and will need to **provide a recent test score to the college**.

Students interested in taking classes through USF may take the CPT on their Tampa campus or may take the CPT test with USF online. Applications must be completed prior to requesting a test appointment through USF.
