


Suncoast Polytechnical High School Hardware and Software Requirements 2016 - 2017

Minimum Recommended Hardware:

- ✓ 2 Gigahertz CPU with 4 Gigabyte of RAM
- ✓ DVD-Rom/ CD-RW drive (is no longer *required*)
- ✓ Broadband Internet Connection (Verizon DSL/FIOS, or Comcast Cable Modem) Dial-up internet connections are not recommended.
- ✓ Sound Card and Speakers/Headphones
- ✓ Printer Black/White or Color
- ✓ USB Flash drive (memory capacity of 2 Gigabytes minimum recommended)

Required Software (Mostly Free):

- ✓ Windows 7 Operating System
- ✓ Windows 10 is fine as well
- ✓ Internet Explorer 11
- ✓ Latest Sun Java (free from <http://www.java.com/en/download/index.jsp>)
- ✓ Some type of Anti-Virus that is up-to-date. Such as:
 - Norton
 - McAfee
 - Windows Essentials is FREE from Microsoft.com
- ✓ Microsoft Office 2010 / 2013 (2013 is preferred) or compatible Office software
- ✓ Microsoft 2016 can be downloaded for free by logging in to Sarasota County School website, Office 365 link, your N # account, download on up to 5 computers.
- ✓ Up-to-date installations of: Adobe Acrobat, Flashplayer, and Shockwave Player (free from <http://www.adobe.com>)
- ✓ Quicktime Latest Version available (free from <http://www.quicktime.com>)
